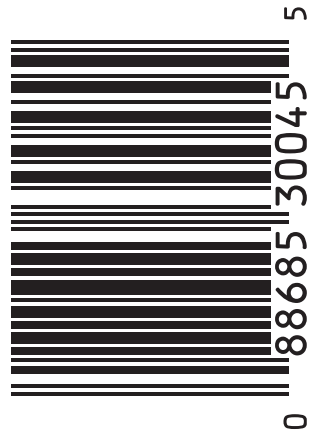

GREENVIEW PREMIUM FORMULA SPRING FERTILIZER WEED & FEED and CRABGRASS PREVENTER will control your lawn's weeds in one application. GREENVIEW PREMIUM FORMULA SPRING FERTILIZER WEED & FEED and CRABGRASS PREVENTER will kill lawn weeds as listed, which are commonly found in home lawns including dandelion, chickweed, thistle and clover; and will prevent crabgrass and other undesirable annual grasses. GREENVIEW PREMIUM FORMULA SPRING FERTILIZER WEED & FEED and CRABGRASS PREVENTER also contains a long-lasting, timed release fertilizer that has all the nutrients your lawn needs for 2 to 3 months, depending on grass variety. Use of GREENVIEW PREMIUM FORMULA SPRING FERTILIZER WEED & FEED and CRABGRASS PREVENTER on lawns and ornamental turfgrasses that are not well established, or have been weakened by stress due to mechanical operations, pests, excessive temperatures, or lack of moisture may increase the chances for turfgrass injury. Allow turfgrasses weakened by these stresses to recover before application of this product. GREENVIEW PREMIUM FORMULA SPRING FERTILIZER WEED & FEED and CRABGRASS PREVENTER is recommended for the following established turf species:
Established Cool Season Turfgrasses - Kentucky bluegrass, perennial ryegrass, fine and tall fescues.
Established Warm Season Turfgrasses - Bahiagrass, bermudagrass, buffalograss, centipedegrass, zoysiagrass, St. Augustinegrass (except 'Florantam'). Do not use this product on seedling buffalograss in the spring of the first year of establishment until the turfgrass is fully green and has established new roots.
Do not use GREENVIEW PREMIUM FORMULA SPRING FERTILIZER WEED & FEED and CRABGRASS PREVENTER on colonial bentgrass, dichondra, carpetgrass, or 'Florantam' St. Augustinegrass.
If the lawn has been seeded recently, wait until after the third mowing before using this product. Do not seed, overseed or sprig the treated area for 10 weeks after application.

WHEN TO APPLY
GREENVIEW PREMIUM FORMULA SPRING FERTILIZER WEED & FEED and CRABGRASS PREVENTER can be used either in the spring or fall. GREENVIEW PREMIUM FORMULA SPRING FERTILIZER WEED & FEED and CRABGRASS PREVENTER should be used when the grass and weeds are actively growing and the soil is moist. Do not apply under drought conditions.
IN THE SPRING: The ideal time to apply GREENVIEW PREMIUM FORMULA SPRING FERTILIZER WEED & FEED and CRABGRASS PREVENTER is after the forsythia has bloomed or when the first dandelion flowers appear. In southern areas (see map), make a second application of GREENVIEW PREMIUM FORMULA SPRING FERTILIZER WEED & FEED and CRABGRASS PREVENTER in 6 to 8 weeks for best weed and crabgrass control and for full season fertilization.
IN THE FALL: Apply GREENVIEW PREMIUM FORMULA SPRING FERTILIZER WEED & FEED and CRABGRASS PREVENTER when the weather cools and both the grass and weeds are actively growing, generally around Labor Day.



HOW TO APPLY
This product needs to stick to the leaves of broadleaf weeds and should be applied when the grass is wet from dew or rain; poor results will occur if it is applied to dry lawns. The lawn should not be watered or disturbed for 24 hours after application. Delay mowing for 3 days after application.
Apply this product when the wind is calm. Do not apply this product onto desirable plants or shrubs as damage may result. If the product gets onto other plants immediately brush or wash it off the foliage.
Use a drop or rotary spreader designed to apply granular fertilizers. Avoid skips or excessive overlaps as poor weed control or turfgrass injury may result.

HOW MUCH TO USE
Apply 3.6 pounds of product per 1,000 sq. ft. of turfgrass.
In New York State: Do not exceed one application at the recommended rate of 3.6 lb of product per 1,000 sq. ft. (0.25 lb active ingredient of dithiopyr per acre).
Other States: The maximum broadcast application rate is 3.6 pounds of product per 1,000 sq. ft. per application (1.0 lb 2,4-D as 0.22 lb MCPP + as 0.09 lb dicamba as 0.25 lb dithiopyr per acre per application). The maximum number of broadcast applications is limited to 2 per year with a minimum of 30 days between applications. The maximum seasonal rate is 7.2 pounds of product per 1,000 sq. ft. (2.0 lb 2,4-D as 0.44 lb MCPP + as 0.18 lb dicamba as 0.50 lb dithiopyr per acre per year).
Apply only to actively growing turf.
NOTE: Supplemental applications of lawn fertilizer may be needed to achieve a minimum 1 pound nitrogen per 1,000 sq. ft.

BROADCAST SPREADER SETTINGS	
Broadcast Spreader Settings: Apply in a single pass at a rate of approximately 3.6 lb per 1,000 sq. ft. Start on the outside border and apply in a circular path working toward the center. A little overlap coverage is desirable.	
Drop Spreader Settings: Apply in a single pass at a rate of approximately 3.6 lb per 1,000 sq. ft. Start on the outside border and apply in a rectangular path working toward the center. Overlap the coverage slightly, and shut off the spreader before making hard turns.
